MARSHALL COUNTY CONTINUATION BOARD MEETING MAY 22, 2014

The Marshall County Board met in the Marshall County Court Room for the May Continuation Board meeting on May 22, 2014 at 8:30am. Chairman Kroeschen called the meeting to order. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, roll call shows: Chairman Kroeschen, Lindstrom, Waldschmidt, Gauwitz, McGrath, Stash, Johnson and McLaughlin and Durham present; Vice-Chairman McGlasson absent.

Chairman Kroeschen noted that the Health Department submitted a letter to the Board that might be attached to the Board's letter to the Department of Agriculture. Durham pointed out some changes to the Board's proposed letter. Lindstrom questioned some details of the County Engineer's attachment to the County Board letter. Durham noted a specific change to page 5, paragraph following item IV of the proposed letter, from 11 to 14 homes. Durham suggested making reference to an attached Health Department letter within the Board letter, noting specifics from the Health Department letter. Durham also outlined the specific correspondences included within the Board's proposal.
