## MARSHALL COUNTY BOARD MEETING May 12, 2016

The Marshall County Board met in the Marshall County Board Room for the May Board meeting on May 12, 2016 at 8:30am. Chairman Kroeschen called the meeting to order. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, roll call shows: Bakewell, Gauwitz, Johnson, Kunckey, Chairman Kroeschen, Lindstrom, Vice Chairman McGlasson, McGrath, McLaughlin, and Minnick, was absent. Stash and Waldschmidt were absent.

It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Gauwitz to **approve the minutes** for 04/14/2016 as presented. Vote shows all ayes, 0 nays, 2 absent, motion carried.

Diana Rawlings (Public Health Administrator) along with Kaylee Halberg and Kurt Kuchle from the Marshall County Health Department presented the Annual Report for 2015. Rawlings stated that the financials are on page 10 of the report.

#16-33 The Marshall County Health Food Safety Ordinance was presented and includes the new codes. Lindstrom moved to adopt the Health and Food Safety Ordinance and Johnson seconded. Vote shows all ayes, 0 nays and 2 absent.

#16-34 Marshall County Health Department Environmental Health Fee Schedule Ordinance was presented. The fees have not been changed for over 20 years. All fees collected are deposited into the Health Department Fund. Johnson moved to adopt the Marshall County Health Department Environmental Fee Schedule. Lindstrom seconded. Vote shows: all ayes, 0 nays and 2 absent.

County Engineer Pat Sloan reported that bids are due and will be opened for three bridges on Tuesday, May 17, 2016 at 8:30 a.m. The projects are for timber pile repairs in LaPrairie and Evans Townships and a box culvert in Magnolia Township. Sloan also reported that Tax School Road needs to be designated as Class III Truck Route for its entire length as a condition to the Truck Access Route Program. It is already designated Class III from Rt. 26 to Washburn Road. A resolution will need to be passed.

Sloan reported that the electronics collection event was highly successful. A total of 60,000 pounds of electronics was collected. Sloan thanked McLaughlin, Johnson, Bakewell and Kroeschen for volunteering their time to help.

Sloan also reported that the Zoning Board of Appeals held a hearing on April 21, 2016 and are recommending approval on two applications,
