

North Central Behavioral Health Systems (NCBHS), Inc. provides individual and family counseling/therapy to individuals in need of services due to a diagnosable behavioral health issue. In addition, community support services are offered to individuals that need extra support within their community or home setting, and need help with daily living skills and/or help with securing resources or entitlements for which they may be eligible. Services are available in the county Monday through Friday by a qualified staff member. NCBHS also provides crisis support through its Canton or LaSalle offices which includes telephone support when the offices are closed. Once a month, telepsychiatry services are available in Marshall County in which active consumers of services are able to access the specialty services of a Board Certified Psychiatrist through the use of telehealth equipment.
