Adoption of the Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan

WHEREAS, the Bureau, LaSalle, Marshall, Putnam, and Stark Counties Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan has been prepared in accordance with FEMA requirements at 44 C.F.R. 201.6; and,

WHEREAS, Marshall County has participated in the preparation of a multi-jurisdictional plan, the Bureau, LaSalle, Marshall, Putnam, and Stark Counties Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan; and,

WHEREAS, Marshall County is a local unit of government that has afforded the citizens an opportunity to comment and provide input in the Plan and the actions in the Plan; and,
