NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Marshall County Board approves the following amendment to the FY 2017 budget, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Marshall County Board that the following budget amendment within the General Fund be and the same are hereby ordered.


