AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE COUNTY OF MARSHALL AMENDED ELECTRICITY AGGREGATION PROGRAM PLAN OF OPERATION AND GOVERNANCE

WHEREAS, the County Board finds that the best interests of the County of Marshall are served by amending the County of Marshall Plans of Operation and Governance to continue the opt-out electricity aggregation program and to revise the program according to the terms of the Illinois Power Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3855/1-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, Section 1-92 of the Illinois Power Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3855/1-92, requires the County to revise the plan of operation and governance for the electricity aggregation program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of the County of Marshall, Illinois, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The County's Electricity Aggregation Program Plan of Operation and Governance, in substantially the form of the copy of said Plan attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, be amended and the same is hereby authorized and approved.

<u>Section 2.</u> The County's electricity aggregation program shall be operated and governed in accordance with said Electricity Aggregation Program Plan of Operation and Governance, the applicable provisions of the Illinois Power Agency Act, and any applicable rules and regulations that are now or in the future adopted pursuant to the Act.
