The undersigned Commissioner of Highways of Bennington Plain Road District in Marshall County, Illinois, hereby petitions you for aid as provided for in Chapter 605, Section5/5-501, of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, for an appropriation from the County Board Bridge Fund in the County Treasury, a sum sufficient to meet one-half the expense required on the condition that said Road District shall furnish the other one-half of the required amount.

A bridge needs to be replaced across the South Branch of Crow Creek located on on TR140C (2700E), Section 28, approximately 4 miles south of Toluca.

The total cost of said work will be approximately \$500,000 with funding from the Township Bridge Program, Rebuild Illinois, MFT and local funds. Estimated local funds are \$105,000 from County & Township, each.
