

ORDINANCE NO. 20-82

**Budget Amendment  
Aid to Township (County) Bridge Fund**

**WHEREAS**, the Marshall County Board adopted the annual budget and appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year ending November 30, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, 55 ILCS 5/6-1003 states, "After the adoption of the county budget, no further appropriations shall be made at any other time during such fiscal year, except as provided in this Division. Transfers from one appropriation of any one fund to another of the same fund, not affecting the total amount appropriated, may be made at any meeting of the board by two-thirds vote of all the members constituting such board, the vote to be taken by ayes and nays and entered on the record of the meeting. By a like vote the board may make appropriations in excess those authorized by the budget in order to meet an immediate emergency.";

**WHEREAS**, several emergency situations required unexpected expenditures, including repairing a bridge that was damaged by an accident (\$16,243) and preplacing a large culvert washed out in Whitefield Township (\$66,077);

**WHEREAS**, the Wenona Road Culvert Replacement Project cost was greater than the estimate (+\$48,528); and

**WHEREAS**, increase revenue from townships for their share of construction projects partially covers the increases (+\$35,000).


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** that the Marshall County Board hereby deems that pursuant to the provisions set forth in 55 ILCS 5/6-1003, that the fiscal year 2020 Annual Appropriation Ordinance be amended as follows:

20-003-57005	Bridges	\$320,000	(+\$120,000)
20-003-57009	Engineering	\$ 20,000	(- \$50,000)
TOTAL FOR FUND		\$456,000	(+\$ 90,000)


