The Marshall-Putnam Fair Association is requesting permission to be granted a Class E liquor license for the beer gardens during the 2021 fair.


We are requesting a license for the dates of Wednesday, July 14th, 2021 to and including Sunday, July 18th, 2021. The beer will be leaving the grounds on Monday July 19th, 2021. The hours of operation will be the regular Marshall County hours. The Marshall-Putnam Fair Association will provide evidence of insurance when the policy is issued. There will be two beer gardens in operation. The main location will be in the Activity Building Wednesday to Sunday. The infield location will be operational Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday. We will fence both locations.

The Marshall Putnam Fair Association is going to host, A Night at the Races (Harness), which includes wine sampling on Wednesday July 14, 2021. This will be the seventh year for this event. We are hosting our wine tasting in the Hunt Building because the Kick Off Dinner will be going on in the Activity Building. It is our goal to have country elegance at our Harness Racing event, by offering an Illinois Wine with our County Fair Tradition of Harness Racing.

The Board of Directors will monitor the ongoing Covid 19, Re-Store Illinois guidelines during our County Fair. The Bureau Marshall Putnam County Health Departments have always worked closely with our two county fair.
