Special Use Permit #21-243 Richland Township Solar, LLC

WHEREAS, the Marshall County Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on October 21, 2021, for ZBA #21-243 Application for Special Use and Variance requested by Richland Township Solar, LLC (the "Applicant"), a limited liability company indirectly owned by Trajectory Energy Partners, LLC ("Trajectory"), submitting on behalf of the landowners, Todd Alan White and Troy Daniel White, for development of a 35-50 MW large scale solar energy project. The Applicant proposes to develop the solar project on cultivated land on six parcels, 12-36-100-001, 12-36-100-002, 12-36-100-004 12-36-200-001, 12-36-200-002, and 12-36-200-010, consisting of approximately 223 acres, located in an Agricultural District. The land is located one-half mile north of Washburn, Illinois between North Lynn Street (extended), Tax School Road (100) and IL Rt. 89. A variance to exceed the maximum lot coverage area (Section 8.2-7), a variance to extend the timeline of commencement in an AG District to 36 months.

WHEREAS, the Marshall County Zoning Board of Appeals imposed conditions on the recommendation including site plan presented on 10-21-2021, with a variance to exceed the maximum lot coverage and 36 months prior to construction, with conditions that a decommissioning bond and road use agreement be approved prior to issuing building permit.

WHEREAS, the Marshall County Zoning Board of Appeals voted to recommend approval of ZBA #21-243 Application for Special Use and Variances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Marshall County Board hereby approves the Special Use Permit and Variances #21-243 to Richland Township Solar, LLC.
