We would like to add two digital repeater locations in the county, one on the very west end around RT 40 and RT 17 Junction. One located on the south end of the county to help improve communications in the RT 29 Hopewell village area and Rt 26 south of Lacon in the Sun Road area. Estimate includes all radio equipment including the internet hardware to connect these repeaters to our existing system. This estimate is to add our radio equipment to an existing tower in a suitable location. This would expand our radio coverage in those areas to provide a faster response to all police and medical emergencies including ones that are Covid-19 related.

Cost estimate \$20,000.00

We would like to add three radios to our current system in dispatch. Two of the radios would be used to provide more capability to page out the responding EMS and Fire departments to all emergency calls including ones for Covid -19.

The other radio would provide our dispatchers the capability to use the state wide Star-Com P25 network to contact other area and state departments by radio. This addition would greatly update our ability to contact needed emergency and medical response teams as needed for any major incident including the Covid-19 pandemic.

Cost Estimate \$8,500.00

Purchase two UVC Light wands to provide a germ and virus killing option for all of the hard surfaces in our dispatch area. We would like to also purchase a UVC HEPA air purifier for the dispatch area. This would provide another germ and virus prevention option to help eliminate the spreading of the covid-19 virus.

Cost Estimate \$305.00
