Resolution of Adoption of the
2022 Marshall-Putnam Counties Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan

WHEREAS, Marshall County is subject to natural hazards including floods, tornadoes, severe winter storms, severe thunderstorms, and drought among others, that pose risks to public health and property; and

WHEREAS, the County of Marshall County desires to prepare and mitigate for such natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires that local jurisdictions have in place a FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a condition of receipt of certain future Federal mitigation funding after November 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the 2022 Marshall-Putnam Counties Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan was developed in accordance with the regulations of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and the guidance provided by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, Marshall County has participated in developing the 2022 Marshall-Putnam Counties Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan covering member jurisdictions of Marshall-Putnam Counties:

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the County of Marshall hereby:

1. Adopts the 2022 Marshall-Putnam Counties Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of Marshall County and
2. Agrees to participate in the annual and 5-year updates to this Plan.
