

Engineering Technician

Marshall and Putnam Counties are seeking a full-time engineering technician who will serve as the assistant to the County Engineer.

Job Description

The engineering technician will assist the county engineer in most technical duties, including working with township highway commissioners, coordinating with contractors and providing guidance to the county highway maintenance crews. The engineering technician will need to work independently, be self-motivated and responsible for the duties assigned. The assistant will conduct construction observation and resident engineering for transportation projects, including documentation, measurement of quantities and materials inspection. Work product will need to comply with appropriate contract types, including Motor Fuel Tax (MFT), Township Bridge Program (TBP), Federal Surface Transportation Funding (STR) and Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT). The technician will read and understand plans and specifications and conduct basic layout duties. The technician will work under the direction of the county engineer, with other team members and other technical duties may be assigned.

Minimum Requirements

Valid driver's license.

High school diploma.

Demonstrated verbal and written skills.

Preferred Qualifications

Associate or bachelor's degree with a technical focus, college level technical course work, or specialized training/certifications.

Computer skills.

Experience as an engineering technician and resident engineer.

Experience with plans and specifications and contract documentation.

NBIS certified bridge inspector.
