MARSHALL COUNTY BOARD MEETING May 11, 2023

The Marshall County Board met for the May Board meeting on May 11, 2023; at 8:30 A.M. Chairman Kroeschen called the meeting to order. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, roll call shows: Gauwitz, Meierkord, Chairman Kroeschen, Stash, Minnick, Balensiefen, Lueders, Vice-Chairman McGlasson, Durham and Fecht present and 2 absent.

It was moved by Lueders and seconded by Balensiefen to **approve** the April 13, 2023; minutes as presented. Vote shows: all ayes, 0 nays, and 2 absent.

No Health Department update was given.

Ryan Giacometti gave the update on Zoning. The next hearing will be on May 18th at 7:00PM for a special use permit for two meteorological towers. On April 20th they had a hearing for a Solar Energy Text Amendment and a Special Use Permit for Midwest Gun Collectors Association.

Greg Crank was present who is the owner of the Midwest Gun Collectors Association and stated this will take 3-5 years before it will be up and ready for use. They have worked out an agreement with Lockport Duck Club on the operation of hours. It was recommended by the Zoning Board that trees be planted on the southern berm and will be hydro seeded and grass planted.

Assistant Engineer Catherine Terando reported on Highway. The maintainers have installed a few field entrances and are starting to shoulder the roads. They are still waiting on the sub-contractor for Bennington Bridge. Things are going smoothly on Camp Grove Bridge they just poured the first pier. They have met and sent in the road use agreement to Trans-Alta for Western Road.

They received two bids for the new building at the Highway. One bid being 2.6 million and the other being 1.1 million. The lowest bid was from Blunier Builders. 75 to 80 percent of the building will be storage for the Highway Department and it will have a concrete floor, EMA Office will be moved out there and a meeting room/board room will be there as well. The meeting/board room will stay set up, so we don't have to take it down each time. The funds will come from the rest of the American Rescue grant money which is a little over \$800,000 and the Highway will fund . The builder will start construction this year.
