MARSHALL COUNTY BOARD MEETING July 13, 2023

The Marshall County Board met for the July Board meeting on July 13, 2023; at 10:00 A.M. Chairman Kroeschen called the meeting to order. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, roll call shows: Gauwitz, Lindstrom, Chairman Kroeschen, Vice Chairman McGlasson, McLaughlin, Minnick, Balensiefen, Meierkord, Lueders, Durham and Fecht present. Stash was absent.

Members and officials attended the 102nd County Fair for Senior Day.

It was moved by Balensiefen and seconded by Minnick to **approve** the June 8, 2023; minutes as presented. Vote shows: all ayes, 0 nays, and 1 absent.

No Health Department update was given.

Ryan Giacometti gave the update on Zoning. A public hearing is scheduled for July 20th at 7:00 PM at the Courthouse for a Special Use Permit that is requested by Rick Jesse to operate Jesse's Wrecker Service and Storage Yard at 501 County Rd 1900E Varna. On May 18th a hearing was held for a Special Use Permit that was requested by Trans Alta to place two met towers on two parcels that are owned by Charles Holz, Alvin and Vivian Knack. The towers will be used until the end of 2025. Chad Macy a Senior Representative from Trans Alta was present.

Assistant Engineer Catherine Terando was present and gave the update on Highway. She reported that spray patching is completed for the year. The maintainers dealt with down powerlines and trees causing road closure on La Prairie Road after a storm. They are working on cleaning out the old storage sheds and getting ready to work on demolishing them. MFT is completed on the west side of the county and road work on the east side of the county will start in a few months. The beams are set for the bridge replacement for Camp Grove Road Bridge. The bridge replacement for Roberts came in too high and they are looking at it. They currently have 40 bridges to inspect on the west side of the county in the next 2 months. They currently have 6 bridges that are under 50%. There are 100 bridges in the County. They try to replace at least 2 bridges a year to keep up with the maintenance on them.

County Engineer Pat Sloan reported that Catherine has passed her first test and is doing a great job!

Port Authority Update: Vice Chairman McGlasson introduced Robert Sinkler, Chris Smith and Dr. Anshu Singh from the Heart of Illinois Regional Port District which covers 5 Counties (Fulton, Mason, Peoria, Tazewell, and Woodford). This district is to improve development on the river. In 2021 200 miles of port was created on the Illinois River. They were very excited to report that the national ports were reported on the GIS database map. In 2021 a resolution was signed by 9 other counties including Marshall County being one in creating the federally recognized Illinois Waterway Port Organization which would attract more funds to the Waterway. With more funding available this would create more jobs. An informational packet was handed out to each member.

Zoning & Land Use: Nothing to report.

Public Comments: Keith Barth who lives in Bell Plain Township and is from Pattonsburg came back to the meeting to see what the update status was on his neighbor operating a mining operation out by Pattonsburg. Chairman Kroeschen stated that he has talked to the Zoning Administrator and Sheriff, and they are working on it. Kroeschen noted that Warnke does have a permit and any issues or concerns with the road are a township issue not a county issue. Barth asked how did he receive a permit? Chairman Kroeschen stated that this discussion was not on the agenda and should not be discussed. Barth stated he was here a year ago and it couldn't be discussed at a meeting, so they went to the State's Attorney Office and was told to file a complaint with the Sheriff. Barth stated that there is a process in doing things in the County. Barth also stated that Warnke does whatever he wants whether its county, township etc. he doesn't understand why everyone is scared of him. Barth stated he would like the permit to be rescinded as he feels Warnke didn't follow proper procedures. County Engineer Pat Sloan stated that he gave him a permit without having a hearing as he is compliant with the current zoning rules and setbacks. Sloan handed out a handout to each member and it stated that in 2022 the operation was approved as a waste site by IDOT. Lindstrom stated that he is an approved contractor from IDOT. Sloan stated that he and Ryan have both worked with the Federal Government and 2 State of Illinois Agencies and he is complying. He has been working with him to get him compliant.
