

Resolution # 25-89

Re: County Engineer's Salary
Section 26-00000-00-CS

WHEREAS, section 605 ILCS 5/5-201 of the Illinois Revised Statutes provides that "In each County there shall be a County Engineer", and

WHEREAS, the same section further provides as follows:

"Any two or more counties may, with the approval of the Department, appoint the same person as County Engineer for each of the counties and may by agreement provide for the proportionate share of the salary and expenses of such appointee to be borne by each County..." and

WHEREAS, Marshall and Putnam Counties have an existing intergovernmental agreement outlining the shared costs for the position of County Engineer, and,

WHEREAS, the Counties have need to establish the County Engineer's salary and have agreed to use 60% of 95% of the sum of the recommended salary levels set by the Illinois Department of Transportation, and,

WHEREAS, such an approach allows the counties to transfer Federal Surface Transportation money to pay one-half of the County Engineer's salary as long as the salary amounts to 60% of 95% of the sum of the recommended salaries for both counties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Marshall County and the County Board of Putnam County that said salary is hereby approved and adopted by the aforesaid County Boards and may be signed by the appropriate personnel as using the Department of Transportation form in words and figures as attached hereto or incorporated herein by reference, effective January 1, 2026 to December 31, 2026.
