County Engineer Catherine Terando gave an update. She stated that the maintainers have responded to the snow events and are working on trimming brush and trees on the west side of the County. Harvest Bridge project is complete and the gravel is down. She has submitted the estimates for MFT for County and Townships. IDOT is considering replacing 3 bridges in Steuben Township as a part of the bundling program. The information has been sent in for this project.
